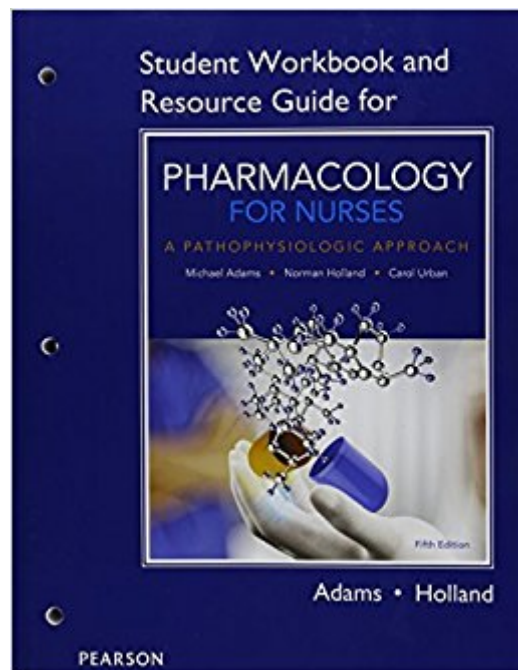

And questions that are multiple choice, are then given essay responses in the corresponding answer key. I spent more time trying to figure out where the correct answer was than actually using it as a study guide.
