

I simply must say that this is one of the better books on the tarot that I've read. The author does have some stigmas related to his practice of the tarot, however it is kept to a minimum, and the clarity and conciseness used in this book really puts a lot of my other tarot resources to shame...and that's without even mentioning the scope of information. the author covers the major arcana's relation to numerology (all 22 cards) unlike most who just skim the first nine digits and leave you hanging past that. And the author also relates multiple occult tradition's ways of looking at the

tarot...whether or not you are motivated by the occult or not these are still time honored traditions used men and women for hundreds of years, thus making them a force in the realm of mysticism...that much cannot be denied even in the most liberal of societies. I am all for breaking tradition(s), but you must know what and why you choose to break said tradition first...otherwise you are just blowing smoke.

Love love love this one. I use morgan-greer tarot so I got the book that went with that deck. I was so disappointed. A friend has used this book forever so I decided to buy it. It has accurate explanations and pictures of the different set ups out there. I prefer the celtic cross set up personally. The pictures are nice because you can distinguish them well which makes it a great book for new learners and seasoned readers alike and you can match with pretty much any deck out there for readings. I would recommend this book in a heart beat to anyone.

Order was processed and delivered on time, with the other purchase a set of cards. So that was very useful to arrive at the same time. My old paperback copy has completely fallen apart.. I had painted the cards with watercolours a long time ago. They are only black and white line drawings, one for each card on each page. The style is of the Rider Waite set of images. Opposite has some general symbolism and traditional meanings ascribed to each card, including reversed. No long passages of doctrines. There are some layouts discussed briefly. I like the book just to peruse, and get some inspiration.

This book is absolutely packed to the brim with information on the all the cards in the Tarot. It gives a lot of perspective into symbolism, general interpretation, how to actually read the cards, the suits & a 3-D view into all the card in the Major Arcana. As someone who was totally overwhelmed by the technicalities of Tarot & had nowhere to start, this book was the book that helped construct the foundation.

The price is right for this book. There are probably better books out there on the Tarot, in all honesty (Dusty White's books come to mind), but I haven't come across any that can compete with this price.

I bought this book initially in 1970, when I was 17, with a deck of tarot cards for my mother. I turned out to be the reader most using the cards, however. I absolutely loved this book! Of all books with which to begin learning, this one alone is simple enough, yet involves spiritual and deeper meanings of the cards as well. I didn't need the book for long, but kept it as it was still nice to turn to once in a while. While no longer a new reader--I still found it oddly inspiring. Many years later, I read other tarot books, some simple, some much more involved, for experienced readers. Nonetheless, I never ever forgot Eden Gray's book, which did \*not\* use key words as the predominant method of teaching, thankfully. :-) Rather Ms. Gray showed us a variety of meanings, which stimulates our own imaginations and intuitive senses; she also touched on astrological and Kabbalistic connections or parallels throughout the book. Of course other books have included these other disciplines also, but Ms. Gray did so in an unusually subtle, but straightforward way. Years later, after a housefire, I bought myself another The Complete Guide to the Tarot from , just to have on hand, (Thank goodness had a few listed, as this was a special edition not available to the general public) However, I also bought yet \*another\* copy for a younger woman in my new neighborhood, who had begun learning to do readings. Her own words on receiving the book were "Oh, good, wonderful, it has illustrations!" and "I know it has to be good if \*you\* learned on this one!" I recommend this book for especially the new, but more multifaceted, intuitive younger reader.
