

I got it as a gift for a friend and in my peeks into it, it is just as funny and unsettling as I had hoped. It is a great gag gift, complete with instructions on how to make your own crap taxidermy. They are different sections for different kinds of "crap taxidermy", like "it's all in the eyes" where a taxidermist went rogue and put either googly eyes on it or they just look really wrong. There is also an

anthropomorphic one, where it features some taxidermy does doing more human things, like fishing or wearing clothes, most of which are well done taxidermy, but odd in their own way! I'd recommend this to anyone who can get a chuckle over a job badly done.

This book is full of amazingly bad pictures. Everyone who sees it ends up laughing and scratching their heads in amazement. This is my go to coffee table book. I think it is well put together and a great value for the price. I still laugh when I go through it and I've had it for a couple of months.
