As a team of veteran travel writers, Darwin Porter and Danforth Prince have written dozens of previous titles for Frommer's, including many of their guides to Europe as well as the Caribbean, Bermuda, and the Bahamas. They are also the authors of Frommer's The Carolinas and Georgia and Portable Savannah. Porter, a noted celebrity biographer, is a native of North Carolina and has lived in both Georgia and South Carolina. We found this guide mediocre at best. If you are not interested in anything related to the history of slavery, this is your guide. Especially since it glosses over so much history. It's the fast food of travel books. If you ARE interested in the fact that the slave population outnumbered residents 3 to 1 in Charleston, this is NOT your guide. Just like the city of Charleston (which was a major port), it seems the book doesn't really want to acknowledge its history. The individuals that built, tortured and were separated from their families deserve more than 2 paragraphs in this book. Pay your respects at the Old Slave Mart and read the newspaper articles carefully preserved to document the history of slavery in Charleston.
