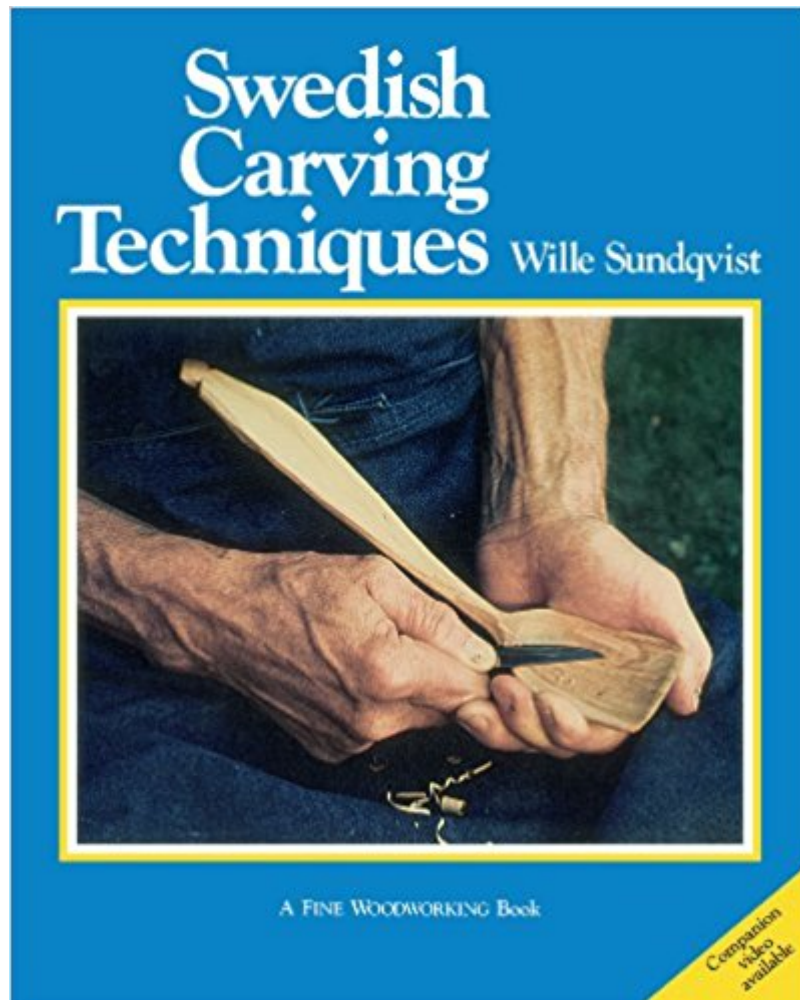




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Swedish Carving Techniques (Fine Woodworking)

Wille Sundqvist learned to carve as a boy from his father and grandfather. He was formerly one of Sweden's Provincial Handcrafts Consultants and is the author of an earlier Swedish book, *Woodturning, the Cutting Method*, as well as several magazine and journal articles.

I never thought I would be able to get a copy of this book. Way back in 1992 I bought Jogge (Wille's son) VHS tape: *Carving Swedish Woodenware*. I have watched it dozens of times. I did not buy this, the companion book by Wille Sundqvist...what a fool was I. Last year (2013), I was looking to get the video on DVD- without much luck. This book was available, USED, at several sites....for close to a THOUSAND BUCKS !!! Then I read on a couple sites Taunton Press was considering reprinting this book, and reissuing the video on DVD. Man, did I jump on them both when I had them on my site ! Woo-Hoot....I got lucky and got them both ! If you have any interest in Carving, Woodenware, techniques, tool construction- do not hesitate to purchase these (the book and the video on DVD) while they are still available. You too will refer to them often- because they are Masterwork !

This book was out of print for the longest time and was selling for really expensive prices. Now that they are printing new copies again I decided to pick up a copy to learn Swedish carving techniques. It covers everything from choosing and maintaining your carving tools, sharpening your tools, ax work, knife grips and talking about different carving projects as well as carving wood selection. Overall I learned new things in every chapter of this book but the two I found most useful was the knife grips section and the carving techniques section. I would recommend this book for anyone looking to get into traditional wood carving.

I received this book as a gift from my husband. I just decided recently that I would like to start

learning to carve wood and maybe make some spoons for my kitchen and for others as gifts. This book is really good for the person learning to carve. There is so much information to take in. It was written by someone who has been carving for most of his life and also teaching. His instructions are very clear and concise and easy to understand. I would recommend this book to anyone interested in carving.
