Joe Lancaster seems to have an issue with Sophia, as he literally keeps on bumping into her. He is staying with his uncle, helping out in his hotel by Lake Garda for the summer. The two find comfort in one another, but neither are looking for love, but maybe love is looking for them? Love at the Italian Lake, is a beautiful chick lit novel. It is as gorgeous on the inside, as it is on the out. Sophia is a lovely young woman who worked all the hours she could to do well for herself, but that all came crashing down in a matter of minutes when she arrived home early. Just when she is down on her luck, she finds herself in a scenic little village by Lake Garda, Italy, with her Nonna, and the gorgeous Joe just down the road. However, not everything is that simple.
