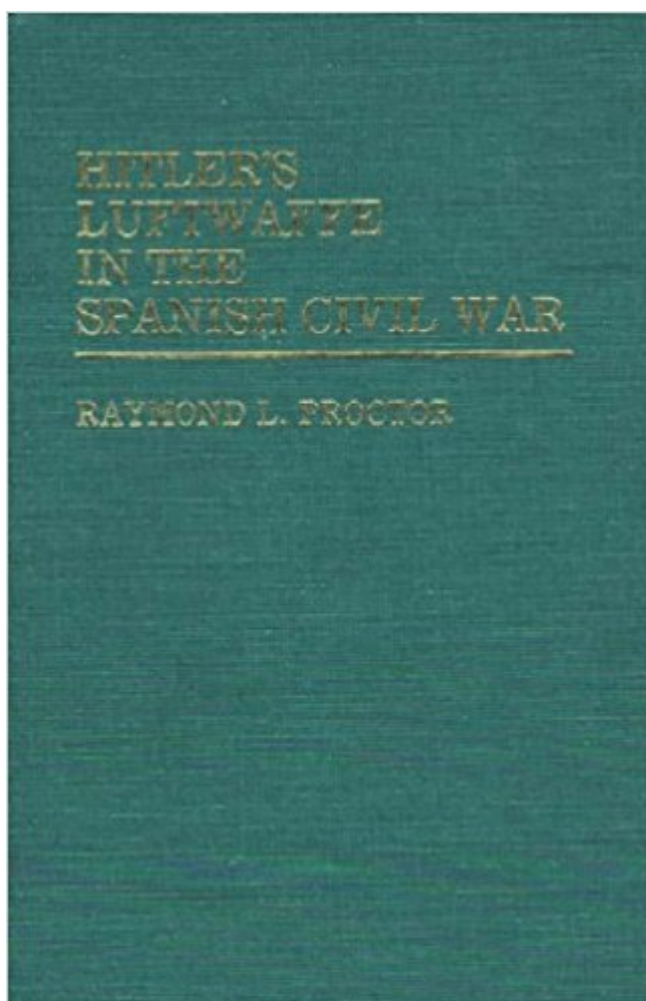


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Hitler's Luftwaffe In The Spanish Civil War (Contributions In Military Studies)

He investigates the problems encountered by the legion in Spain, including its organization, the extent of its training, the nature of its personnel, communications, and logistics, and the experience of operating in a foreign country as one of three allied forces in the civil war. The author provides detailed information about the German involvement in critical battles such as the Aragon Offensive, the Battle of Ebro, and the final assault on Catalonia. Proctor also assesses how effectively the Luftwaffe applied the lessons it learned in Spain to World War II and analyzes the lessons it missed.

The author provides impressive detail concerning all events and the major campaigns such as the Republican Brunete Offensive, that include the numbers of tanks, guns, MGs etc., and the tactical course of events that transpired, and the unimaginable confusion that reigned over the battlefield reducing the effectiveness of the Republican attack that then became stalled and then stopped and reversed. The author provides incredible detail on the composition of the Republican Forces, and the allocation of Tanks involved.
