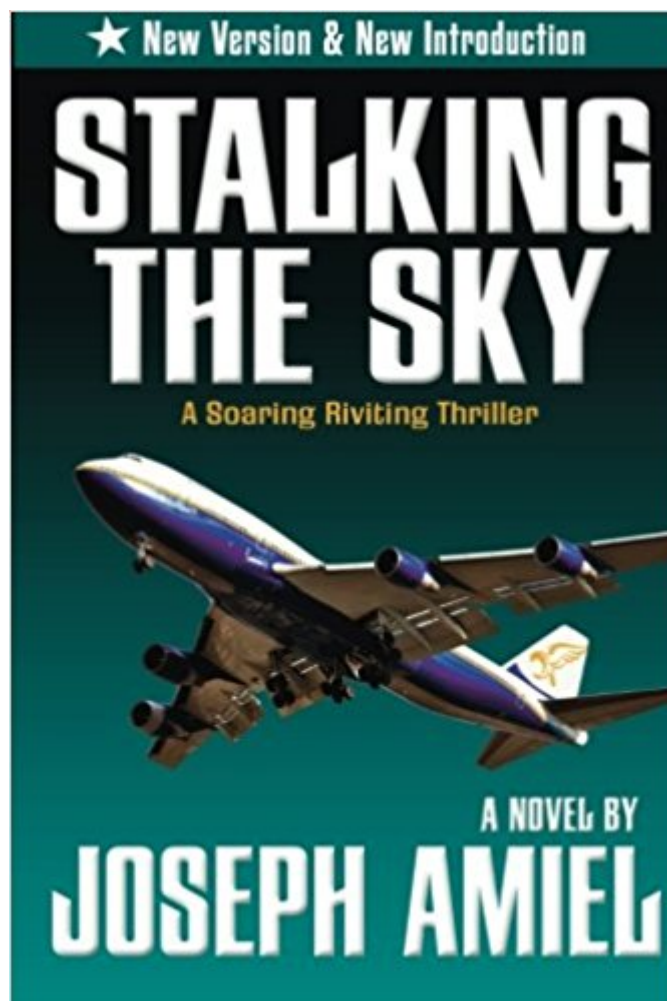


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Stalking The Sky

As I created the plot, I knew that certainly a bomb of some sort had to be employed with the killer able to escape after placing it, but how to accomplish that and how does one place it in the absolutely precise place to disable a giant aircraft built to survive a multitude of in-air mishaps? Long days of desperate thought were required to devise a solution that sounded good in theory, but if it didn't ring true in practice, the plot would appear ludicrous for lack of credibility. In short I needed to be sure my scheme would work. I certainly wasn't going to place a real bomb on a flying airliner, but I could go through enough of the steps to be sure it was possible. On a vacation trip with my wife, I entered the jetliner's lavatory and, filled with trepidation, sure I was about to be apprehended as a terrorist, I went through enough of the steps my murderer would be taking to place the bomb to the point where there was no doubt the scheme would work. Fearing arrest at any moment, I returned, sweating, to my seat. Included with the book is a new, rather personal Introduction about how this book came to be and how it magically transformed me into a successful novelist. My research also made me an expert on airlines and air crashes. Included in the Introduction is an anecdote about how I used that expertise to gain media interviews, and nearly ended up humiliating myself until a last-second recollection allowed me to finish on a triumphant note. I think you'll enjoy both my revealing Introduction and, more important, my suspense novel STALKING THE SKY.
