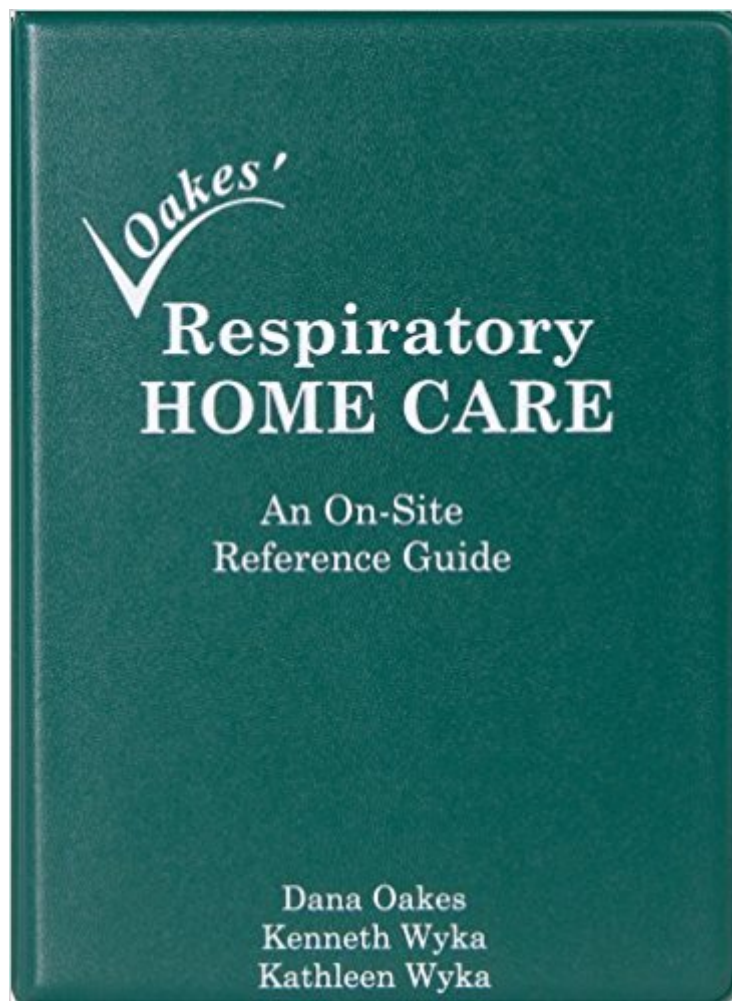

This book does for Home Care what Dana Oakes' "Clinical Practitioner's Pocket Guide to Respiratory Care" does for Respiratory Care in general. It is co-authored with Kenneth and Kathleen Wyka, widely recognized as experts in the emerging home care world. Home Care Therapists are increasingly being required to do within the home what was only possible previously in the clinical setting. Because of this, they absolutely need to have an encyclopedic amount of information ready

for immediate use. Carrying a pile of textbooks would likely do the trick, but isn't practical; "Respiratory Home Care: An On-Site Reference Guide" condenses and organizes the information most needed.
