

I echo the other reviewers. This was indeed an easy to read and enjoyable book. It peaked my interest into delving more into Old Testament studies. I also loved that they included sections on Christ as well as where to find law and grace in each section of the OT.

As a parish pastor, I have just finished reading this excellent text, which was a top-notch resource for teaching a survey of the books of the Old Testament. In Bible class we did a weekly overview of each book of the Bible (this volume is only of the Old Testament, Genesis--Malachi). As an introduction to each book, Steinmann and Lessing explore the place each holds in the canon, the typical author, date, background context, and major themes running through each book. Invaluable was a section in each chapter showing how that particular book of the Old Testament points forward to the Christ, either through prophecy, type, themes, etc. Following that was a section on sin and grace, how they feature in the books of the Bible. Viewing a book from a "20,000 foot" perspective is really amazing, when you get to see how larger threads and themes weave together through scripture, that you might not have noticed at your usual "eye-level" view. This book will be valuable for seminarians, college students in OT survey courses, pastors in the parish, and studious lay people. The book is marked by a high respect for the inspired and inerrant Word of God; a carefully reasoned defense against higher criticism, and an understanding of the spiritual use of the Scriptures to engender faith in Christ. I am also familiar with other writings of both Steinmann and Lessing, and highly recommend this and other works by both. God bless your study of the Old Testament! This will certainly enrich it.
