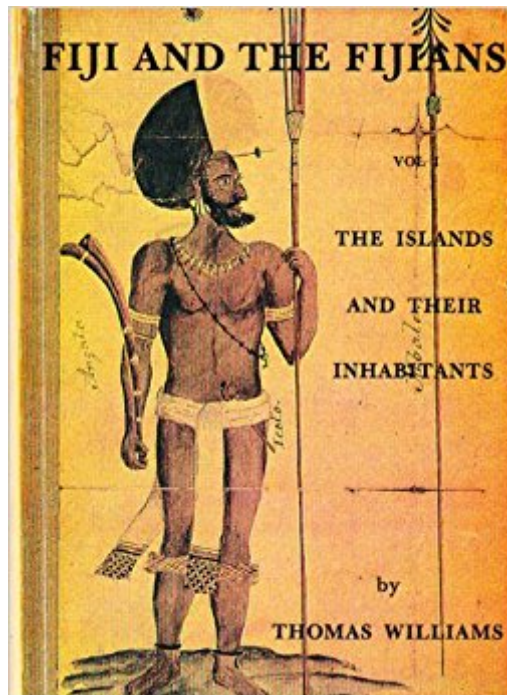

As regards the consonants, the Missionaries found that the Fijian did not require all the characters used by ourselves some of these were therefore rejected, while some were employed where we have recourse to a clumsy combination.
