

MADELEINE L’ENGLE (1918–2007) was the author of many acclaimed books for children and adults. The other books in the Time Quintet include *Many Waters* and *An Acceptable Time*.

I cannot count how many L’Engle books from the *Wrinkle In Time* series I’ve purchased for young people. This was a replacement for one that had water damage.

This book is for young adult readers, although I enjoyed it too. My granddaughter called me one evening to tell me she was reading an "enchanted" book and she thought that I would like it. I did. It’s a whimsical story about three children who, in Harry Potter style, become involved in dimensions they do not understand. They are guided by three spirits with the delightful names of Mrs. Whatsit, Mrs. Who, and Mrs. Which. Another spirit that they encounter is Mrs. Happy Medium. It is a much lighter read than Harry Potter books, and it does not involve violence.

Have such fond memories of this trilogy from when I was a pre-teen. Wanted to read it again as a 40+ adult. The science in the later books bothers me a bit more than it did then, mostly because I’ve studied science by now. LOL. BUT, what a great introduction to sci-fi/speculative fiction.

This book impacted me profoundly as a child, and still does today. A huge influence on my own writing!

There’s not much to say really. If you haven’t read the quintet (there’s five books in this set) yet and you like stuff like the Harry Potter series, then this is definitely worth a try. Start with the first book though. :) I read all five books within 2 weeks. So yeah, loved them, too bad I’ve gone through them

already. A wrinkle in time is my favourite, but all of them are worth your time. I will definitely be looking into more stuff written by Madeleine l'Engle. These are the five books in the quintet: 1. A Wrinkle in Time 2. A Wind in the Door 3. A Swiftly Tilting Planet 4. Many Waters 5. An Acceptable Time
